Blanchard Receives Diamond Pin After 25 Years With Edison Co.

More than a hundred employees and friends of G. L. "Lee" Blanchard, Southern California Edison Co. district manager, met last week to celebrate his 25th anniversary with the utility company.

Held in San Pedro, the affair attracted guests from as far away as San Bernardino and Ventura. They witnessed the presentation of a diamond-studded, 25-year Edison pin to Blanchard.

Making the presentation was George N. Hawley, vice president of the company, who hired Blanchard in San Bernardino in 1933.

Blanchard has served in Pomona, Covina and Long Beach, in addition to his assignment with the company's frequency change department from 1945 to 1948, when the power firm converted its product from 50 to 60 cycles.

He was district manager at Ontario until 1951, then at Inglewood until named manager of the Redondo Beach district in 1953.

He and Mrs. Blanchard live in Palms Verde Estates and have two married daughters and three grandchildren.
