**Torrance Maintains Lead In Area Chest Campaign**

The Torrance Community Chest campaign, entering its final phase with 85 per cent of its total goal collected, is at the moment tied with the Gardena campaign for top place in the Harbor Area.

Torrance's residential division was the second to reach 100 per cent of its goal by last week end. Gardena, which had an original lead, was third to report 100 per cent, following Torrance by one day.

Commerce and industry divisions in Torrance are leading the other Harbor cities with 84 per cent of their goal reported, and \$2326 yet to be raised. The advance gifts division has collected 75 per cent of its quota. Lagging behind is the small business division which has achieved only 51 per cent of its \$1257 goal.

AGAIN COMMENDING the women volunteers for the

speed with which they completed the residential campaign Jim Becker, Torrance city chairman, urged that the men volunteers in commerce and industry, small business and advance gifts fresh up their assignments this week before the holiday time interferes.

He urged volunteers to consider the importance of meeting the needs of all 167 Community Chest agencies this year, and asked them to keep in mind that children are waiting for help from many of these agencies.

"Only the full goal we have set for this year can insure that no child will be left waiting. It is of paramount importance that we make this goal. One out of every four families in this area benefits from a Community Chest agency. We must complete our campaign this week," said Becker.
