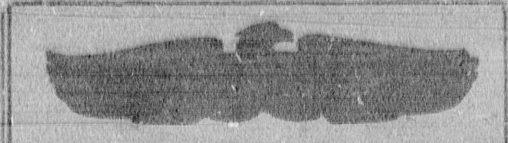
## R. H. Masons to Install Newly Elected Officers
