## Doctor Yeh Joins Ramo Research Lab

Dr. Gordon Chien-Kuan Yeh, of 21305 Ocean Ave., former staff scientist at Reed Research, Inc. Washington, D. C., has joined the research laboratory of the Ramo-Wooldridge Division of Thompson Ramo Wooldridge Inc.

Dr. Yeh has conducted analytical research in the fields of applied mechanics, applied mathematical physics, and mathematical physics, and mathematical physics at the Reed Research Inc. and the Reed Research Foundation. He has been a reviewer for the Applied Mechanics Reviews since 1951, and is the author of numerous technical papers.

Dr. Yeh received the B.Sc. degree in aeronautical engineering in 1945 from the National Central University, China. then attended Stanford University, receiving the M.Sc. degree in engineering mechanics in 1948. In 1949 he received the Sc.M. degree in applied mechanics while a Gordon McKay Scholar at Harvard University; and in 1951, as a Gordon McKay Fellow at Harvard, he received the ScD. degree in applied mechanics. He was a research assistant, and later a teaching assistant at Harvard University.
