ORDINANCE NO. 1114
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRENCE AMENDING APPENDIX I OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRENCE, 1954 (ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 791) RECLASSIFYING THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION CASE NO. 569.

WHEREAS, the City Council deems that it is to the public interest that certain changes in land use (zoning) classification be made in certain real property in the City of Torrance as hereinafter described in Section 3, (as applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 569) and:

WHEREAS, due and legal publication of notice has been given to the owners of property in the vicinity thereof and public hearings have been held and regularly held, all as required by Appendix I of the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954, and the statutes of the State of California;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.
That the City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby find and determine that the Change of Zone applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 569 as more particularly described in Section 3 hereof, is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of substantial property rights of the owners of the property in the vicinity thereof, and that Change of Zone will not be materially detrimental to the public welfare of the City of Torrance, and that the Change of Zone is in accordance with the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954, and the statutes of the State of California; that opportunity has been afforded to interested parties as therein provided, to protest the proposed Change of Zone before the Planning Commission of the City of Torrance; and that hearings on the application have been held as therein provided.

SECTION 2.
That said Change of Zone reclassification and changing the said property hereinafter described and more particularly indicated on the map marked Exhibit B, of the Code of the Land Use Map, which is an exhibit to and by reference made a part of Appendix I of the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954, and which is on file in the office of the City Engineer, and that said Change is hereby approved; that the said Land Use Map of the City of Torrance is hereby amended to show such reclassification and zoning; and that the portion of said Map as amended and thereto attached to show such a part of said Land Use Map of the City of Torrance and is hereby substituted for the portion of the original Land Use Map covering the property herein reclassified.

SECTION 3.
That the property to be reclassified is described as follows:
"All that certain parcel of property situated in the City of Torrance, County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows:
Parcel 1: Starting at a point at the South line of Sepulveda Boulevard and the East line of Eucalyptus Street, as recorded in Map Book 430, pp. 44 to 46, thence South 47° 47' West 711' (plus or minus) feet along said Eucalyptus Street, thence South 52° 23' 55" East 83.9' feet to the next East line of Lot 1, Tract 17201, thence North 1/4° West 17201 feet North to the West line of Palms Verdes Boulevard, thence South 1/4° East to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot "B", Rancho Palms Verdes.
Parcel 2: Starting at a point at the Northwest corner of Sepulveda Boulevard and Palms Verdes Boulevard, thence South along the East line of Palms Verdes Boulevard and Southeast along the North line of Lomita Boulevard, to the West line of Lot 1, Tract 17201, recorded in Map Book 447, pp. 19 to 21, thence North along said West line to the South line of Sepulveda Blvd., 100 feet to the West line of said South line, thence West along said South line to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot "B", Rancho Palms Verdes.
Parcel 3: Starting at a point at the Northwest corner of Sepulveda Boulevard and Palms Verdes Boulevard, thence South along the East line of Palms Verdes Boulevard and Southeast along the North line of Lomita Boulevard, to the West line of Lot 1, Tract 17201, recorded in Map Book 447, pp. 19 to 21, thence North along said West line to the South line of Sepulveda Blvd., 100 feet to the West line of said South line, thence West along said South line to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot "B", Rancho Palms Verdes.
Parcel 4: Starting at a point at the Northwest corner of Sepulveda Boulevard and Palms Verdes Boulevard, thence South along the East line of Palms Verdes Boulevard and Southeast along the North line of Lomita Boulevard, to the West line of Lot 1, Tract 17201, recorded in Map Book 447, pp. 19 to 21, thence North along said West line to the South line of Sepulveda Blvd., 100 feet to the West line of said South line, thence West along said South line to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot "B", Rancho Palms Verdes.
Parcel 5: Starting at a point at the Northwest corner of Sepulveda Boulevard and Palms Verdes Boulevard, thence South along the East line of Palms Verdes Boulevard and Southeast along the North line of Lomita Boulevard, to the West line of Lot 1, Tract 17201, recorded in Map Book 447, pp. 19 to 21, thence North along said West line to the South line of Sepulveda Blvd., 100 feet to the West line of said South line, thence West along said South line to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot "B", Rancho Palms Verdes.

That said property described in Section 3 hereof, and the same is hereby reclassified from A-1 (Light Agriculture) to C-3 (Solely Commercial) zoning.

SECTION 5.
That all Ordinances of the City of Torrance, inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.
This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
