If the voters approve the multi-billion dollar bond issue involved, which seems likely, California will be enabled to start the biggest engineering job of history to date, to bring water to all the thirsty parts of the state.

OUR PUBLIC schools and colleges have always been one of our principal legislative concerns. In the budget we provided a substantial increase in state funds for their sup-port. Our long range studies of educational standards and problems which grew out of public concern over the qual-ity of instruction provided our youth were considerably ad-vanced by the work of our committee of legislators and citizens.
