Anyone who goes into wild areas, whether camping or hunting, should definitely be alert to the dangers of bubonic plague. Plague caused the death of a resident of Ventura County just about two years ago, and a Boy Scout from Walnut Creek contracted the disease within the past month while on a camping trip in the remote areas of Yosemite Na-tional Park. Although recovering, he is still hospitalized.

THE PLAGUE . INFESTED THE PLAGUE. INFESTED flea that transmits this disease is usually found on small rodents, including porcupines, gophers, rabbits, rats, mice and squirrels, particularly the latter. In turn, the fleas may also infest larger animals such as the deer and bear, or even domestic rodents in urban areas. All campers should take quick leave of areas where sick or dead animals are found and or dead animals are found and also refrain from handling them.

In wild animals the disease In wild animals the disease is called sylvatic plague; in human cases it is called bubonic plague, taking its name from the pustular swellings of the lymph glands (bubbes) that occur on the body. The disease in man not uncommonly ends in pneumonic and when it does in pneumonia and when it does In this form, it can be passed from person to person and is often fatal.

ALTHOUGH plague is not the dreaded disease it once was, it is still a potential danger. Altogether, there have been two human cases in California since 1947. However, sylatic plague has been found ratic plague has been found in 36 of the 54 counties of the state, including Los Angeles County.

As a precaution against the plague, do not handle any small animals, use insect repellents around the campsite, and shake out sleeping bags and clothing regularly.

FIRE is also among the ma-for dangers that may beset a camper, particularly in a drought year such as this one. In areas where fires are con-sidered a hazard, certain sections have been set aside by the Forester and Fire Warden where fires may be lit. To, exrerise independent judgment in this matter is to run the danger of setting fire to thousands of acres of timber, killing off the wildlife and endangering human life. A first aid snake bite kit is a must in the list of necessi-ties for campers. Should any-one be bitten, however, it is important to get medical aid as quickly as possible. Snake bite kits usually contain but one vial of antivenim serum whereas several are generally needed to overcome the effects of the venom. The cut and suction first aid method in snake bite is something every camp-er who goes into snake-infested reas should know.

. . . TICKS are not much of a problem in Los Angeles Coun-ty, although recently the pa-jaroello tick has caused some apprehension. This tick, which has been found around low-growing shrubs in the foothill areas of Los Angeles County, is a slow mover and it is only when a person rests or sleeps in the tick's habitat that it has time to fasten itself on him for the purpose of getting

There is no specific antidote There is no specific antidote for the bite of this tick and first aid treatment usually consists of removing as much saliva as possible from the wound by employing suction, using either the mouth or a suchion apparatus. The appli-
