Thompson, the director of racing for this non-profit drag strip which is sponsored by nine Long Beach area Lions Clubs, announced that he'll fire up the home-built stream-liner and let it roll the length of the quartermile strip. Mickey and his crew will be on hand to answer all questions from 3:30 o'clock until 10:45 o'clock when the strip closes after more than seven hours of time and speed trials.

The Thompson Challenger is lowered by four 500 horse-power Pontiac engines, each with a displacement of 410 cubic inches. They are mounted in pairs to each axel, and with fuel injection turn from 5800 to 6000 fevolutions per minute.

The car in which the late John Cobb of England set the 394.2 MPH mark had two 1300 horsepower engines. It was 26 feet long, eight feet wide and


