Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the State Highway Engineer, Room 406, Division of Highways Building, 120 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, California, until 2 o'clock p.m., on September 3, 1959, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in Room 2 of said building, for construction on State Highway in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows:

- Los Angeles County, in the City of Torrance, about 0.9 mile N.W. of Hawthorne Avenue (VII-L.A.-60-707), a pedestrian overcrossing to be constructed.
- Bids are required for the entire work described herein.
- In accordance with the provisions of Section 1770 of the Labor Code of the State of California, the Department of Public Works has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages in the county in which the work is to be done as follows:

Any classification omitted herein not less than \$2.50 per hour, one and one-half (1 1/2) times the above rates. Sundays and holidays - not less than one and one-half (1 1/2) times the above rates. The holidays upon which such rates shall be paid shall be all holidays recognized by the collective bargaining agreement applicable to the particular craft, classification or type of workman employed on the project.

Attention is directed to Section 7, article 1, paragraph (7) of the Standard Specifications providing for employment of apprentices on the work. Every such apprentice shall be paid the standard wage paid to apprentices under the regulations of the trade in which he is employed. Information relative to employment of apprentices shall be obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, who is the Administrative Officer of the California Apprenticeship Council.

Plans, specifications, and standard proposal form to be used for bidding on this project can only be obtained at the office of the State Highway Engineer, Public Works Building, Sacramento, California.

Plans and specifications may be seen at the office of the State Highway Engineer at Sacramento, at the offices of the District Engineers at Los Angeles and San Francisco, and at the office of the District Engineer of the district in which the work is situated, and at the office of the Associated General Contractors in San Francisco.

No bid will be considered unless it is made on a blank form furnished by the State Highway Engineer and is made in accordance with the provisions of the Proposal Requirements and Conditions set forth under Section 2 of the Standard Specifications. Each bidder must be licensed and also prequalified as required by law. (See said Proposal Requirements and Conditions.)

The Department of Public Works reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SELL COUNTY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, has found and determined that the County-owned property hereinafter described is not required for public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as follows:

1. That it is the intention of said Board of Supervisors on the 17th day of September 1959, at 9:30 a.m., in its office at 601 Hall of Records, Los Angeles 12, California, to sell for cash and under the following terms and conditions, a portion of County-owned property located on the east side of Normandie Avenue, 833 1/2 feet northerly of Sepulveda Boulevard, in the unincorporated County area lying easterly of the City of Torrance, and more particularly described as follows:

The southerly 20 feet of the westerly 125.83 feet of that portion of Lot A, Tract No. 3020, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on map recorded in Book 31, page 19 of Maps of the County of Los Angeles, which lies northerly of a line parallel with and 300 feet southerly, measured at right angles, from that certain course in the northerly boundary of said lot, shown as having a length of 251.66 feet on said map.

Reserving and excepting unto the County of Los Angeles an easement for public road and highway purposes over the westerly 20 feet of the above described parcel of land, together with the right to set aside for public use.

Also reserving and excepting unto the County of Los Angeles all oil, gas, hydrocarbons or other minerals in and under the above described land, without the right of surface entry for the development thereof.

SUBJECT TO AND BUYER TO ASSUME:

1. All taxes, interest, penalties, and assessments of record, if any.

2. Covenants, conditions, restrictions, reservations, easements and rights of way of record, if any.

Said real property consists of an unimproved rectangular section of land, dimensioned 50 feet x 125.83 feet, containing a net usable area after reservation of a 40-foot road easement of 4,292 square feet, and zoned M-1 (light manufacturing).

Electric and telephone services are the only public utilities immediately available to the subject property.

2. Sealed bids must be filed in the office of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, at 601 Hall of Records, Los Angeles 12, California, prior to 9:30 a.m. on the 17th day of September, 1959, which is the date set for the public meeting of said Board of Supervisors to receive and consider said sealed bids. At the same time and place oral bids will be heard to the time that oral bids are called for, all bid requirements set forth in this notice have been met by the oral bidder, and further provided that bid oral bids shall exceed by at least five per cent (5%) the highest sealed bid. It is the intention of this paragraph that any bid requirements set forth herein shall apply to sealed bids and oral bids alike.

3. The bidder to purchase said property of less than TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$2,300.00) will be considered by said Board.

4. The said Board reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, on the 4th day of August, 1959.
