Fall School Bus Schedules for **Torrance District Announced**

Torrance school busses, which last year carried some 630,000 children nearly 400,000 miles, are ready again this fall to carry youngsters to local schools.

Busses will carry students in high schools if they live more than two miles away. Elementary students are transported if they live more than a mile away.

Despite an increase in enrollment, fewer students will be bussed to school this year. Seven new schools were opened last year bringing buildings closer to the students and requiring less service. The district hires 17 drivers full-time and 10 part-time. The part-time drivers drive cars to transport handicapped children.
