HILL IS well qualified to answer questions about Tro-jan athletes, having entered the University of Southern California in 1927, starred on baseball and football teams, and graduated with cum laude honors.

After a 10-year professional baseball career with the Yankees, Senators, and Athletics, he began coaching football at Corona High, moved on to Riverside Junior College, then Long Beach Junior College before returning to SC's coaching staff in 1946.

SINCE returning to SC, Hill has fielded two national championship track and field teams, and in 1952 steered the grid varsity to an undefeated conference season, and became the only coast team to give the Big Ten its lumps by walking off with the Rose Bowl honors.

During the afternoon a special section has been reserved for the UCLA-Washington foot-ball game at Memorial Coli-


