

Miss Hayes, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Rex Hayes, formerly of Hollywood Riviera, outof Hollywood Riviera, out-scored over 550,000 competing students to win her position as a semi-finalist. She has been a South Bay resident for many years and a Marymount student since her high school

freshman year.

MISS HAYES is one of the highest scorers on the Na-tional Merit Scholarship Quali-fying Test, the nation-wide test of educational develop-ment given in over 14,500 high schools last spring.

Miss Hayes now faces another rigorous, three-hour examination, the Scholastic Aptitude Test of the College Entrance Examination Board, which, will further confirm her high score on the NMSQT. This second test will be given in testing centers throughout the U.S. on Dec. 5, 1959. Those who repeat their high scores on this second test will become finalists in the com-petition.
