

VA Approves Rivierans to Benefits for **Discuss** Type

Enemy Aliens Veterans Service Officer Bessie D. Slonecker noted to-day that the Veterans Admin-istration has been authorized, by newly signed Public Law 86-113, to pay benefits to cer-tain, veterans discharged as charge was at their own re-quest.

charge was at their own re-quest. During World War I, instruc-tions were issued by the Sec-retary of War that aliens in the U.S. military service, who were from countries with which we were at war, should be discharged if they so re-quested. However, the instructions were misunderstood in some

However, the instructions were misunderstood in some cases and many such allens were discharged arbitrarily. Those who wanted to remain in service were therefore the victims of an injustice, because they were grouped with the allens who did request dis-charge and were subsequently denied any veterans benefits. The new law provides that no individual will be consid-ered to have been discharged as an alien at his own request unless there is affirmative evidence that he was so dis-charged.

Thus, the burden of proof has been switched from the veteran to the military authorities. 


