session of the legislature on the subject of air pollution to run concurrently with the 1960 budget session next March.

There are indications, too, that support for the enactment of smog control legislation on the state level is stronger than it has ever been since this problem reached its present proportions.

ties have concurred in request-ing such legislation, at a spe-cial session of the legislature, and many other governmental bodies and private organiza-tions have joined in this re-quest.

ONE SOURCE of air pollution on which we will be in position to act is that of automobile exhaust emissions.

Early in the 1959 sessions I

introduced, and obtained the enactment of, an urgency measure directing the State Department of Public Health to determine the maximum allowable standards of exhaust contaminants by Feb. 1, 1960.

THIS WAS done in anticipation of a special session in March of 1060, so that the legislature might have before it a definite set of standards upon which to base further legislation requiring that these standards be conformed to

standards be conformed to.

We will thus be well prepared in this particular area of air polluation, upon which the counties have put special emphasis.

My own feeling is that there are other steps that must be taken for the over-all control of air pollution, and that these steps should be taken at the same time as we act on the control of exhaust contaminants.

FROM THE beginning of this discussion in the legislature, my own position has been that air pollution should be recognized as a state, and not merely a local problem, and that we should broaden the area of the state's participation in its control.

Generally, I think there are three directions in which the state should extend its authority and its support.

One is in the creation of uniform standards for the purity of air throughout the state, and the State Department of Public Health has been directed to do this by legislation similar to my own bill relating to exhaust contamination.
