Millard Sheets of Claremont, noted artist- designer, has been commissioned to blueprint the program, according to Board Chairman Howard Ahmanson.


"The \$5 million being spent in the new construction and improvement program will better accommodate thousands of savers," Ahmanson said.

This new gift wrap has just been introduced on the market and already is being featured by top department and station-ery stores throughout the coun-try. The entire laminating and rotogravure printing job is done at this Torrance plant which also has equipment for laminating foil to board stock.




