Telephone Company Lists New Films Now Available

Five new colored films have been added to General Telephone Company's film library, which are now available to schools, churches, civic groups, service clubs and other organizations on a "free loan" basis, said J. M. White, Palos Verdes district manager.

"The Big Reach," a 27 minute film, geared for all age groups, starting with elementary, depicts the Air Force's attempts to reach the moon during the fall of 1958. It shows the difficulties and problems involved: relates comments made by individuals directly connected with the project and shows, through animation, how the moon will be reached through space.

"The Long Right Arm," a 30 minute film, is a story of the evolutionary progress made in logistical aviation, the airlift concept, illustrated with the DC3 through the DC4, 5, and 6 series, C-124 and ending with the C-133. Historical sequences depict the airlift effort through World War II, the Berlin Airlift, Korea and the present IRBM and ICBM logistical support capability.
