Remember Your Friends, Kuchel Says to Labor

U. S. Senator Thomas H. Kuchel of California has advised leaders of organized labor to remember George Washington's warning against "entang-

Coast delegates attending an AFL-CIO legislative conference, the Senate Republican whip also counseled labor leaders to "do a better job of in-forming the American public of your objectives."

KUCHEL'S comments on the way organized labor can help reach its goals came after he reviewed the history of certain recent controversies about legislation particularly affecting labor. He said unions should revive the practice of Samuel Gompers, first Federation of Labor president, to recognize labor's friends regardless of party and to follow the principle of "reward your friends punish your enemies."

Saying organized labior should refuse to become permanently identified with any particular party, Kuchel warned that all Americans "must ever be certain that the two-party system continues in our country and that never will we

country and that never will we see one overpowering political organization — or a multiplicity of political organizations such as has been a weakness of France."

THE UNITED States also must safeguard its ability to make "honorable compromis-Kuchel said, remarking

"this is necessary for progres."

He listed as objectives for organized labor and all other Americans "keep America free, keep America strong, strike for peace with justice, and welcome any honorable area of agreement which could be a step toward disarmament."
