nuch the same work as England's "graunde Inquest" of the Fourteenth century. The grand jury is not the trial jury.
Besides looking into crime, the grand jury looks into the jails and hospitals; the conduct and books of public officials; cases of persons in jail not yet indicted; all crimes done or triable in the county, and the like.

A grand jury can start a prosecution; if a grand juror "knows or has reason to believe" that crime "has been committed, he must declare it to his fellow jurors," who must look into it at once.
But the fellow jurors may not act on mere rumor or suspicion, nor may they go on "fishing expeditions" on the off chance of finding out about a crime.

Since grand jurors have much power, they must be responsible people of standing in the community, often known to the superior court judges who supervise their choice by lot.
Both trial and grand jurors must be 21 years old, speak English, and have their natural faculties.

ORDINANCE NO. 1149
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING APPENDIX I OF "THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954" (ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 791), RECLASSIFYING THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION CASE NO. 601, SITUATED AT THE EAST SIDE OF ARLINGTON AVENUE APPROXIMATELY 140 FEET SOUTH OF REDONDO BEACH BOULEVARD, FROM R-1 TO R-3.
WHEREAS, the City Council deems that it is in the public interest that certain changes in land use (zoning) classification be made in certain real property in the City of Torrance as hereinafter described in Section 3, (as applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 601); and
WHEREAS, due and legal publication of notice has been given to the owners of property in the vicinity thereof and public hearings have been duly and regularly held, all as required by Appendix I of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954";
NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.
That the City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby find and determine that the Change of Zone applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 601, as more particularly described in Section 3 hereof, is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of substantial property rights of the owners of the property in the vicinity thereof; that a 140 Change of Zone will not be materially detrimental to the public welfare or to the property in the vicinity thereof; that notice has been given, as required by Appendix I of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954"; that opportunity has been afforded to interested parties as therein provided, to protest the proposed Change of Zone before the Planning Commission and the City Council of the City of Torrance; and that hearings on the application have been held as therein provided.
SECTION 2.
That said Change of Zone reclassifying and changing the use of said property herein after described and more particularly indicated on the map marked Exhibit "A" known as the Land Use Map, which is an exhibit to and by reference made to Appendix I of "The Code of

the City of Torrance, 1954", and which is on file in the office of the City Engineer, be and the same is hereby amended to show such reclassification and zoning; and that the portion of said Map as amended and thereto attached is hereby made a part of said Land Use Map of the City of Torrance and is hereby substituted for the portion of the original Land Use Map covering the property herein reclassified.
SECTION 3.
That the property to be reclassified is described as follows:
"All that certain real property situated in the City of Torrance, County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows:
Beginning at a point 150 feet Easterly of the Westerly line of Lot 62, McDonald Tract, on the North line of the South 430 feet of said lot; thence North at right angle to said North line 139 feet; thence Easterly parallel to the Northerly line of said Lot 62, 49 feet; thence Southerly to said Northerly line of the Southerly 430 feet of said Lot 62; thence Easterly 49 feet along said Northerly line to the point of beginning, situated at the East side of Arlington Avenue approximately 140 feet South of Redondo Beach Boulevard.

That said property described in Section 3 be, and the same is hereby reclassified from R-1 (Single Family Residential) to R-3 (Limited Multiple Family Residence) zoning.
SECTION 5.
That all Ordinances of the City of Torrance, inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency and no further, are hereby repealed.
SECTION 6.
This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
