Big Worry For Young Woman

Question: Is it unusual for a woman in pregnancy to form large amounts of saliva? —

Answer: Excessive saliva-tion is a rather rare annoyance occuring in association with pregnancy. It is not a serious condition and is not associated condition and is not associated with any complication of the pregnancy. Salivation may occasionally be so great as to present a constant annoyance to the patient, even to the point of preventing sleep. Sometimes, the amount of saliva produced daily exceeds a quart.

The cause of the condition is not known; hence, there is no specific treatment. In most cases, it subsides after the first three months of pregnancy, but occasionaly it persists until after the baby is born. Daily astringent mouth washes may be helpful in alleviating the discomfort.

Q.: What would cause young woman to develop suddenly a bald spot on back of her head? — E.M.

A. This is very likely alopecia areata, a condition in which the hair falls out in localized patches. Sometimes, only a single small spot occurs, and other times multiple areas involving large portions of the scalp may develop.

The cause of alopecia areata is unknown. One theory is that it is a psychosomatic disorder, but this remains to be proved. It is a relatively common condition. For treatment, physicians usually attempt to stimulate heir growth by various measures, aithough spontaneous regrowth may occur.

Q: Is there any way to cure prostate trouble other than surgery? I'm over 70 and dread going under the knife.—C.E.
A.: "Prostate trouble" is an extremely indefinite term, but usually implies the following: a gradual decline in the force of the urinary stream, difficulty in starting and stopping, and, sometimes, dribbling. This may be associated with function, nocturia (getting that night), a feeling of inadequate emptying of the bladder and, occasionally, hematuria thood in the urine). If infection is present, these symptoms

(blood in the urine). If infection is present, these symptoms are exaggerated and burning and urgency occur.

Prostatic surgery by a qualified urologist, after adequate clinical, X-ray and ctystoscopic evaluation, is a highly successful and gartifying procedure and the only known method of cure. As far as age is concerned, patients undergoing prostatic surgery are usually in their 60's and 70's. With modern surgical techniques, proper anesthesia and medicaproper anesthesia and medica-tion, the operative risk is not great.
