THE DISTRICT'S 17 buses also are used to carry students on field trips of various sorts. Cars carry handicapped young-sters to and from classes. Dur-ing the summer, buses were servire and six of them re-painted painted.

North High students will be picked up at 7:40 a.m.; South High students at 12:40 p.m.; and Torrance High stu-dents at 1:40 p.m.
