Garden Checklist

1. Bedding plants for winter color are now avail-le in nurseries. Calendula, Pansy, Viola, Stock and Snapdragons head the list.

2. Spring flowering bulbs can be potted up for some portable colors. Be sure to keep them in a dark, cool place to insure good root growth before the tops push up.

California's native Christmas Berry

Set out (Photinia) now. It's bright berries this Christmas will be a prelude to much more of the same in future years.

4. Dig faded gladiolus as the tops turn yellow. Cut off tops about an inch or less above the bulb; and store the bulbs in a cool dry place until early next year.

5. Buy potted Chrysanthemums in bloom to take the place of those you forgot to plant last spring.
