Ryan UAW Agree to New Terms

A new two-year labor contract has been negotiated between Ryan Aeronautical Co. and the United Auto Workers (AFL-CIO) Local 881 representing production workers at the Torrance plant, company sources reported this week.

The agreement, which runs through Aug. 24, 1962, contains basically the same provisions as the contract between the company and UAW Local 506 at the San Diego plant of Ryan.

Principal features are a 7cent wage increase next year, improvement in employee benefits, and retention of the "escape" period for employees wishing to withdraw from the union.
