California Water Problem Still **Boiling Away as Election Nears**

BEFORE THESE proposals were reviewed, the committee was reminded that under the terms of the water project law enacted in 1959, the Legislature is specifically authorized to prescribe terms ond conditions for water contracts. Furthermore, the act provides that each contract is entered into for the direct benefit of the bond holders and that revenues derived from fullfilment of contracts are pledged to purposes stated in the law.

It is said that the drafts presented are the first comprehensive efforts to put words on paper to spell out agreements and commitments involved in the complex relations between the state, as builder and operator of the project, and the local agency purchasing water. Therefore they cannot be regarded as final, nor necessarily satisfacory to all water agencies who might be involved.

"What price water?" is a twist of "What Price Glory?" the title of the famous play and movie about World War I. But it is also a very serious problem to all of us here in will plague state government and many local water agencies for months to come. Price is a basic factor involved in the drafting of contracts to supply water f r om statewide water project to local agencies which can connect with its aqueducts. A recent two-day hearing on water contracts held by the Assembly interim committee on water demonstrated unmistakably that the water topic still boils with controversy. Three different drafts of proposed contracts brought quite mixed reactions from committee members and representatives of interested groups.

BEFORE THESE proposals were reviewed, the committee was reminded that under the

SPOKESMAN for the state department of water resources differed about the status of its draft. One referred to it as a "staff do c u m e n t only." Another said it is a "complete document," needing only filling in of blanks, and signatures to become effective. It provides for allocation of water available, acerage limitations available, acerage limitations based on price, the extent of state obligations under con-tracts, and for the time and method of repaying capital costs.
