

## Garden Checklist

> 1. Feed Tuberous Begonias if your would have them stay healthy and bloom through next month.
> 2. Start fall clean-up by uprooting faded annuals and raking any leaves that have fallen early.
> 3. Plant berried shrubs for fall color. Pyracantha and Cotoneaster are two of the best for spectacular show.
> 4. Perennials are available in nurseries now for bloom next spring. The earlier you plant them, the better they will be established for an early start next year.
> 5. This is an ideal month to plant native trees and shrubs. Winter rains will establish them and no further attention need be given them.
