1. Bulb planting season is close upon us. Most nurseries have their complete stock of spring bulbs. now.

2. Use blooming pots of Cyclamen to replace Tuberous Begonias as they go out of bloom.

3. Sprinkle new lawns as required to keep moist. Some seeds in the mixture you planted are slow to sprout; and even a slight drying at this time wil cause trouble

4. Divide such perennials as Phlox, Primrose, Shasta Daisy. Plant new perennials from nursery flats for spring bloom.

5. Don't count on early rains to end the need for watering. Water up to and in the wake of fall's first storms.
