Africa, Topic of Study Chosen by AAUW

Africa, once the "Dark Continent" but with 13 nations newly admitted to the U. N., has been chosen as the subject by two study groups of the Palos Verdes-Rolling Hills Branch of the American Association of University Women at their October meetings.

On the 6th the International Relations group, Mrs. Hugh Hixon Chairman, will meet at the Palos Verdes Estates home of Mrs. George Culbertson; and on the 10th the Book Section, Mrs. Dean Dunlavey, Chairman, will convene at Mrs. Raymond Oddone's home in Rolling Hills.

The speaker for the International Relations Study Group will be Mr. Richard Hughes, who with Mrs. Hughes lived from April 1949 to October 1955 in Liberia, where Mr. Hughes taught languages in Cuttington College, an Episcopal mission school at college level. Both Mr. and Mrs. Hughes were graduated from U.C.L.A. where Mr. Hughes also obtained his M.A. in languages. At present he is teaching English in San Pedro High School and in Harbor College. Cuttington College was for many years the only college in Liberia and was situated on the extremely hot and humid

coastal plain. It was moved to the higher and relatively drier interior, where, although it is not an agriculture school it is furthering the growing of such crops as coffee, cocoa, rubber, and citrus fruits on land owned by the college. It has about 200 students and a faculty of 16, four of whom are Liberians, one a Nigerian, and the rest Europeans or Americans.

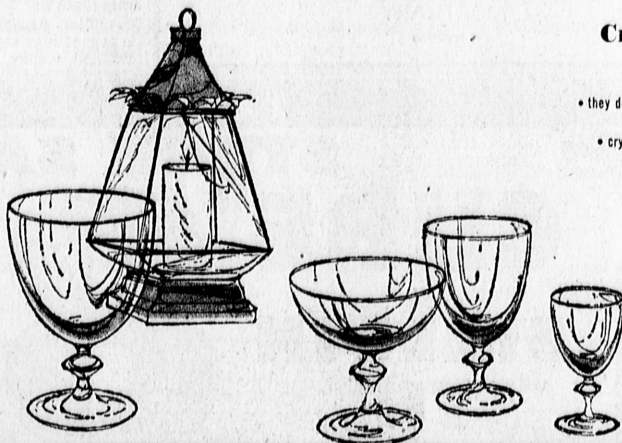
Mr. Hughes will discuss the education, the culture, and the economy of Liberia and will illustrate his talk with pictures made by him and his wife in Africa.

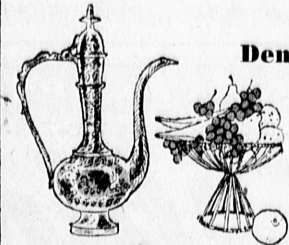

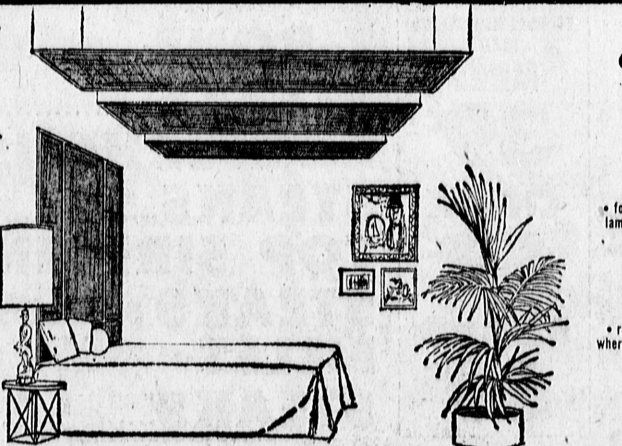
