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SECTION 2. That all aforesaid work and improvement shall be constructed along the lines, between the points, the dimensions, and the grades and in the manner shown on the plans (which include profiles and detailed drawings) for the said work designated "Plan No. SF-13" consisting of sixteen sheets numbered 1 to 16, inclusive, and in accordance with said plans and with the specifications for said work which are designated "Specifications for the Improvement of Calle Mayor and other streets and easements within the Home Improvement Survey Assessment District No. 2." Said plans and specifications have heretofore been approved by the City Council of the City of Torrance and are on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Torrance, and reference is hereby made to said plans and specifications for a full and detailed description of said proposed work and for a description of the easements at which said work is to be done. The estimated cost of said work or improvement, exclusive of the central expenses of the proceedings, is the sum of \$1,696.83.

SECTION 3. That, pursuant to the provisions of the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Major Improvement Act of 1931," being Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, Section 2608, as amended, a report in writing has been made by the Health Officer of the County of Los Angeles to the Board of Health of said County, and that this report has been read in full at the meeting of the City Council, and that this City Council has found by Resolution No. 4048, adopted on the fourth day of October, 1960, that this necessity exists, all in accordance with the provisions of said Section 2608 as amended.

SECTION 4. That in the opinion of this City Council the said contemplated work is of more than local or ordinary public benefit and this City Council hereby makes an expenditure of said work chargeable upon a district, which district this City Council hereby declares to be the district benefited by the said work and to be assessed to pay the costs and expense thereof, which district is described as follows:

All that certain territory in the City of Torrance, California, included within the exterior boundary line shown on the map or plat numbered SF-13-A prepared by the City Engineer, hereinafter approved by the City Council by Resolution No. 4061, adopted on the 27th day of September, 1960, indicating by said boundary line the extent of the territory included within the proposed assessment of said work, and a map or plat is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Torrance, and reference is made to said map or plat for a further full and more particular description of said assessment district, and said map or plat so on file shall govern for all details as to the extent and exterior boundaries of the said assessment district. (Streets and alleys excepted.)

SECTION 5. That serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of fifty dollars (\$50) or over remaining unpaid for thirty (30) days after the second day of January next succeeding the next September 1st following their date. Said bonds are to be issued pursuant to and as provided in the Improvement Act of 1931, Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California. Said bonds shall contain a provision for redemption, providing for a premium of five percent (5%) of the unpaid principal pursuant to Section 464 of the Streets and Highways Code.

SECTION 6. That the said proposed work is to be done under and proceedings therefor are to be under and pursuant to the said Improvement Act of 1931.

SECTION 7. That notice is hereby given that the last day of November, 1960, at the hour of 5:30 o'clock P.M., is the day and hour when, and the place where, any and all persons having any claim or objection to said proposed work or to the extent of said assessment district, or to the proposed work, may appear before the City Council of said City of Torrance and show cause why said proposed work should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution of intention to identify it, and must be delivered in writing and must contain a description of the proposed sufficient to identify it, and must be delivered to the City Clerk of said City of Torrance not later than the hour herein set for hearing protests or objections.

SECTION 8. That the TORRANCE HERALD, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the said City of Torrance is hereby selected as the newspaper in which this resolution shall be published, and consent where otherwise ordered by the City Council, in which all other publications in the proceedings pursuant to this resolution of intention shall be made. The said City Clerk is hereby directed to certify to the adoption of this resolution and to cause said resolution to be published in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 9. That said City Clerk is hereby directed to mail notice of the adoption of this resolution as provided in said Improvement Act of 1931, notice provided to all persons owning real property which is proposed to be assessed to pay any part of the cost of said work whose names and addresses appear on the last updated Assessment roll or as shown to the said City Clerk, including the mailing of such notice to every owner of property assessed to the State under Section 74 of Article XIII of the Constitution at the address shown on the last board roll transmitted to the county auditor.

SECTION 10. That the Superintendent of Streets of the said City of Torrance is hereby directed to cause to be completed, as soon as possible, along the line of the contemplated work and on all open streets within said assessment district notice of the intended resolution of intention in the time form and manner provided by law.
