STATE OF CALIFORNIA - TH 1033 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the State Highway Engineer, 408, Division of Highways Building, 120 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, California, until 2 o'clock p.m. on November 10, 1960, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the presence of the building for construction on state highway in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows:

Los Angeles County, between 0.4 mile south of Route 60 and 0.7 mile north of 20th Street in Los Angeles (W7-LA-165-LA), about 4.7 miles in length, six-lane and eight-lane freeway to be graded and paved with portland cement concrete on cement treated base, asphalt concrete on cement treated base and aggregate base, and a bridge to be widened and overcrossing and 10 bridges to be constructed.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. Plans, specifications, and proposal forms to be used for bidding on this project can only be obtained at the office of the State Highway Engineer, Public Works Building, Sacramento, California.

Plans and specifications may be seen at the office of the State Highway Engineer at Sacramento, at the offices of the District Engineers at Los Angeles and San Francisco, and at the office of the District Engineer of the district in which the work is situated.

No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a blank form furnished by the State Highway Engineer and is made in accordance with the provisions of the Standard Specifications and special provisions. Each bidder must be prequalified as required by law.

The Department of Public Works reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Abbreviations in the schedule of predetermined wage rates in conjunction with employer payments listed in the right hand column are identified as follows:

Employer payments other than those itemized herein, as defined in Section 1773.1 of the Labor Code, are to be paid in accordance with the terms of the collective bargaining agreement applicable to the type or classification of work involved in the project.

Overtime, Sundays and Holidays—not less than one and one-half (1 1/2) times the basic hourly rate plus applicable employer payments. The hourly overtime rate shall be at least 1 1/2 times the basic hourly rate in the collective bargaining agreement applicable to the particular craft, classification or type of workman employed on the project.

Copies of the Standard Specifications and special provisions set forth in the aforementioned Labor Code are on file and available for inspection in the office of the Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Contract Enforcement, 1200 Broadway, San Francisco, California.

Attention is directed to Section 7.101G of the Standard Specifications providing for employment of apprentices and trainees under the regulations of the trade at which he is employed. Information relative to apprenticeship shall be obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, who is the Administrative Officer of the California Apprenticeship Council.

Pursuant to Section 1770 of the Labor Code of the State of California, the Department of Public Works has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages and employer payments for health and welfare, vacation and similar purposes in the county in which the work is to be done to be as follows:
