### Top Episcopal Church Leaders to Meet in Los Angeles Dec. 1 to 3

Top leadership in the Episcopal services to be held at St. Paul's Cathedral, Figueroa at Wilshire Blvd., Los Angeles, and in the Statler Hotel across the boulevard from the Cathedral.

For the first time in its history the council will meet on the West Coast, focusing its interest in the rapid growth and population expansion in Pacific Coast areas. Ordinarily the quarterly sessions are held in Greenwich, Conn., at Seabury House, the national headquarters and conference center of

episcopal Church of the United States will gather in Los Angeles Dec. 1 through 3, for a regional meeting of the church governing body, its National Council.

The presiding bishop of the Episcopal Church, the Rev. Arthur Lichtenberger, will preside at the council sessions and the Church.

Distinguished laymen from all parts of the country, prominent in their own fields, will participate. William H. Siegmund, Pasadena, a southern California executive, serving for the sixth year on the National Council, will represent the Diocese of Los Angeles.

Discussion will center on the church's action concerning current problems of Christian social relations, education, juvenile delinquency and world relief and rehabilitation. All meetings will be open to the public.

On Sunday, Dec. 4, following the close of the council's sessions, the member bishops, priests and distinguished laymen will be guest preachers at more than 60 Episcopal churches in Southern California.
