

Most southern Californians have been stuffed with turkey and ham. So, you can be sure that markets will emphasize that markets will emphasize that markets will emphasize that markets to do a bit of shopping to find values most interesting to you. "Specials" will wary from market to market.

You can make your selection from BEEF, LAMB, FRESH PORK, and ... of course ... POULTRY, which is plentiful. In fact, a record supply of poul-try is being held in freezer storage in readiness for the holidays holidays.

In general (with the exception of market features) you will find PORK prices not taking the drop which we usually expect at this time of the year. Reports estimate 10 to 15 per cent fewer pigs will travel to market this year than last.

This is pot-roast weather. In-stead of the more usual roasts with vegetables your family might enjoy a California Spiced Pot Roast:

California Spiced Pot Roast

5 pound beef pot roast
(chuck or rump)
2 tablespoons fat
1 cup California red table
wine. Salt to taste
3 tablespoons mixed pickling spice

1 cup dried apricots or prunes

Brown roast in hot fat in a heavy kettle. Add wine and spices. Cover tightly and simmer 3 to 3½ hours or until fork tender. If more liquid is required, add water, a small amount at a time. Do not "drown" the meat, During last hour of cooking add fruit. ON THE PRODUCE STANDS
