Savings Firm Has Tallest Lighted Tree

Glendale Federal Savings and Loan Assn. has the largest illuminated Christmas Tree ever seen in Southern California and one of the tallest ever erected in the nation, it was announced today by J. E. Hoelt, president.

The 72-foot tree is constructed atop Glendale Federal's nine-story home office building at 401 N. Brand Blvd., Glendale.

When compared to multi-building heights, the top of the tree stands approximately 16 stories high at its uppermost point.

The trunk of the tree is formed by using a steel tower, erected in sections. Thirty-six streamers of lights form the branches and the outline of the tree. The streamers stretch from the top of the tower to the tree's circular base, which has a diameter of 40 feet. More than 1500 light bulbs are used on the tree, forty on each streamer and 70 on a seven-foot star placed at the top of the tree. The tree uses enough power each night to light approximately 600 five-room homes.

"Because the location of Glendale Federal's home office building provides a complete panorama of the surrounding area, the tree is visible for at least 10 miles on a clear night," Hoelt said. "In addition to blinking out its cheery Christmas greeting to residents within the 10-mile area, the tree will also be visible to hundreds of Golden State Freeway drivers each night."
