Triple anniversary observ-ances were conducted recently by members of Immanuel Lutheran Church, who celebrated the 35th anniversary of the founding of the church, the fifth year of occupancy of the present church and the tenth year of ministry in the church by the Rev. A.L.T. Schuetz.

In behalf of the congrega-tion, Elders Phil Baxter, Herb tion, Elders Phil Baxter, Herb Schultz and W. A. Kamrath presented the Rev. and Mrs. Schuetz a film projector and a cash gift. A 35mm camera was presented to the pastor in June by members of the chil-dten's confirmation class.

DURING THE 10-year period in which the Rev. Schuetz has served the congregation, bap-tized membership has increas-ed from 127 to 740. The pastor

ed from 127 to 740. The pastor has performed 308 baptisms, has confirmed 68 children and received 112 adults into mem-bership through baptism or confirmation. In the same period 54 marri-ages have been performed, while 17 burials were recorded. Communicant membership of the church has increased from 81 to 415. 81 to 415.
