The future of Christianity in India depends upon the effec-tiveness of each individual believer. However, the Christians in rural villages are usually illiterate and often face perilliterate and often have but secution. They are few in number and frequently need encouragement. Several different methods are used to assist them, the Rev. Mr. Major says.

A LAY LEADERS' training school, in which the minister has been active, is the cooper-ative effort of three missions in central India. They return to their normal occupations and serve as leaders in the small churches which do not
