Torrance residents joined with nearly one-third million other Southern Californians during 1960 in boosting Home's during 1960 in boosting Home's savings accounts to an all-time high of \$765,529,777. The 12-month increase of \$154 million is over double the growth of savings accounts ever recorded without merger in any 12-month period by a savings and loan association. The number of savings accounts placed with Home Savings boomed upwards by almost 47,000 in 1960 reaching a total of 225,100 at year end.

HOME SAVINGS poured a record total of \$30,894,205 back to its savers in earning payments in 1960, providing a tremendous reservoir of purchasing power and increased family security. During 1960 earnings were paid at the annual rate of 4½ per cent compounded every three months. This rate will continue for the first quarter of 1961, Ahmanson said.
