## NAACP Leader To Speak Here

Robert F. Williams, president of the Monroe, N.C., branch of the NAACP, will speak on his experiences during several tours through Cuba when he addresses a meeting here at 8 p.m. Sunday at the Pacific Unitarian Church, 1610 Acacia.

Sunday's meeting, being sponsored by the Social Action Committee of the church and the Greater Los Angeles Chapter of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee, will be open to the public without charge.

Williams, a former Marine, edits the weekly newspaper, "The Crusader." He has written and spoken extensively about his experiences during his tours of Cuba. He will emphasize the fight against the "counter-revolution" advocated in Cuba.

Williams led the movement which freed two Negro children two years ago who had been jailed for having allegedly been kissed by a little white girl in a children's game, according to J. R. Denton of the local sponsors.
