This past February has been one of the bloodiest months in the history of the Torrance Police Department according to Lt. Donald Nash, head of the department's Traffic Division.

During the short month, three persons were killed, 41 injury accidents were logged with 71 persons injured, and an additional 44 property damage accidents were recorded.

Two of the three fatalities have not been carried on previous Torrance logs, but were added this week after investigation by Los Angeles County Sheriff's deputies determined that an accident claiming two lives on Redondo Beach Blvd, were within the city's jurisdiction.

Although speed is a factor in almost all traffic accidents, too many times speed was not the actual cause of the erash, Lt. Nash reports.

Failure to yield right-of-way at intersections, and with vehicles leaving private driveways, roads, or from private property are among the more serious and frequent causes of accidents.

To answer the question, "Who has the right-of-way?" the Traffic Division of the local police department has se down the following tips:

- 1. Controlled intersections-Any vehicle that has entered the intersection on the green signal and is delayed within the intersection has the right-of-way, and all other vehicles shall yield right-of-way to allow the vehicle to leave
- 2. Uncontrolled intersections When two vehicles enter an intersection from different highways at the same time, the vehicle on the left shall yield the right-of-way to the one on his right.
- 3. Left-turner at an intersection The driver of any vehicle intending to turn left at an intersection shall yield right-of-way to any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction which is so close as to constitute a hazard at any time during the turning movement.
- 4. Entering onto a through highway-All vehicles shall stop at the entrance to a through highway and yield rightof-way to vehicles approaching on the through highway which are so close as to constitute a hazard.
- 5. Yield signs-Any vehicle approaching a "yield rightof-way" sign shall yield to all vehicles within the intersec tion or approaching so close as to constitute an immediate
- 6. Leaving private road or driveway-Any vehicle about to enter or cross a highway from any private property or private road or driveway or from an alley shall yield to all vehicles approaching on the through highway.

All motorists are cautioned by Traffic Division officers that being discourteous in driving and use of poor judgment is one of the greatest causes of right-of-way violations which result in traffic accidents.

Remember, be a courteous driver, the officers warn.




