16th Annual Sportsmen's Show Opening Doors Today

The 16th annual Los Angeles Sportsmen's and Vacation Show, a \$10 million display of outdoor fun and recreation equipment, opens today at Pan-Pacific Auditorium for a 10-day run.

Largest and one of the oldest outdoor sportsmen's exhibit in the country, the H. Werner Buck extravaganza is studded with entertainment highlights this year. Boats, camping equipment, camper trucks, guns, fishing tackle, sporting goods on display, are valued at more than \$10 million.

TACKLE ROW, an incredible assortment of fishing gear, is another special section of the show, with fishing accessories valued at upward of \$1 million. Gadgets to satisfy the wildest dreams of dedicated fishermen, from dry flies to huge compound deep sea reels, are part of the exhibit.

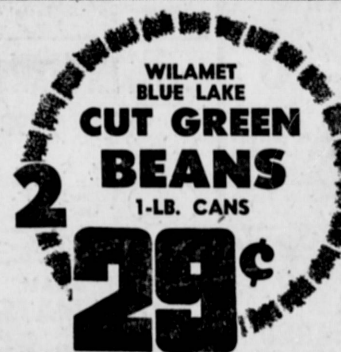
