Edison Co. Pays Final Tax Bill Of \$5,880,793

Southern California Edison Co., one of Los Angeles County's biggest single taxpayers, presented its check for \$5,880,783.75 to Tax Collector H. L. Byram Monday as the second installment of local property taxes for 1960-61.

Total property taxes paid by Edison in Los Angeles county amounts to \$19,758,131.35, according to G. L. Blanchard, Edison district manager. This includes a first installment of \$13,441,715.50 paid to the county in December, plus separate payments to the cities of Long Beach and Pasadena.

About half of the total taxes paid to the county by Edison goes directly toward the sup-

port of local public schools, Blanchard pointed out.

The combined property tax payments that Edison will make to 13 counties in Central and Southern California for 1960 and 1961 will total \$36,562,892.44, he said.

"Taxes paid to local, state and federal governments remain the Edison Company's largest single item of expense, just as they have for the past 12 years," the Edison official stated.

"Last year, Edison paid in taxes to all levels of government a total of \$81,607,956, which amounts to 27 cents of every dollar paid by our customers for their electric service."
