Officiating at the funeral was Keith McRoberts of the Wesleyan Methodist Church of Lawndale.

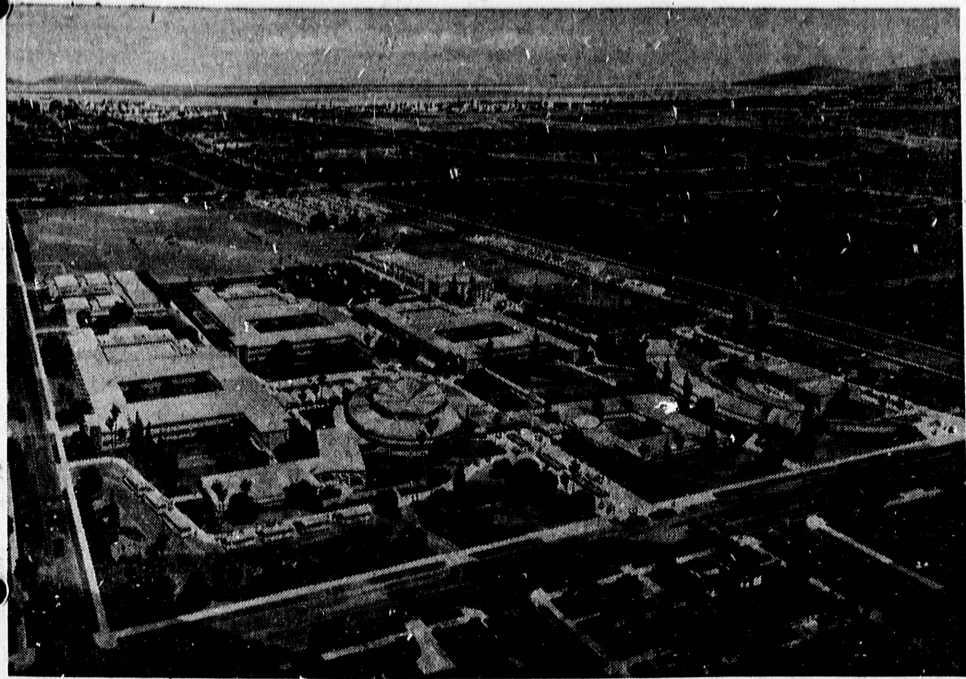
FRERERICK ROE

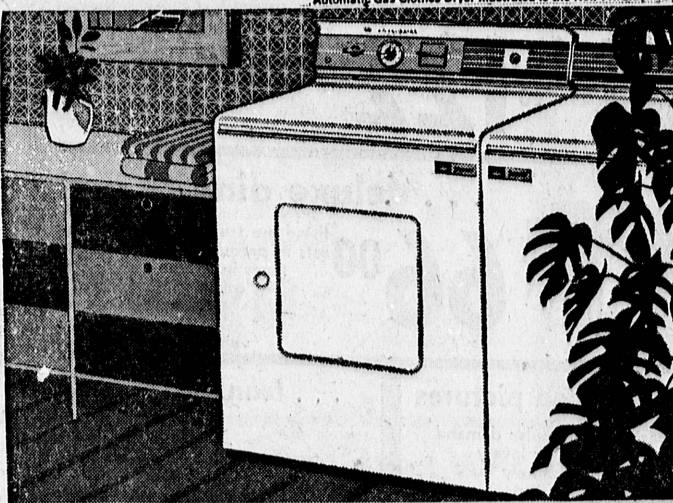
