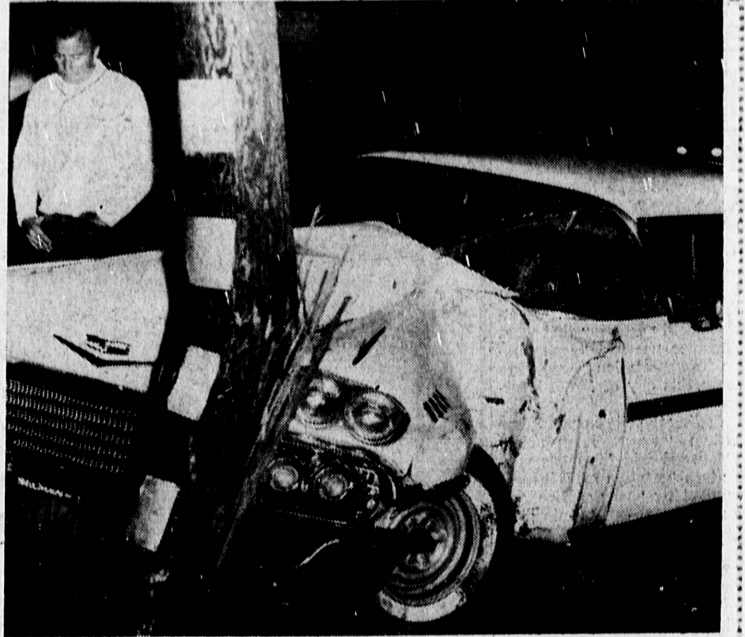
As the Easter season approaches the local church began a month-long campaign to lead the Sunday School and Training Union members to "Crown Him Lord."
