### President of Lutheran College Explains Plans to Local Guild

The Women's Christian Service Guild of the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection, 380 Palos Verdes Blvd., heard an informal talk given by Dr. Orville Dahl at the April 4 meeting of the Guild.

Dr. Dahl, president of the California Lutheran College at Thousand Oaks, was introduced by Mrs. Robert McLaughlin, higher education chairman for the Guild. Dr. Dahl showed the architect's drawings of the college and told of the progress being made in the building program.

FOR MANY YEARS the Lutherans have recognized the need for a college of the church in California and now their plans are a reality, he said. The five church groups represented in the California Lutheran Educational Foundation and pledged to support the new California Lutheran college are: the American Lutheran Church, the Augustana Lutheran Church, the Evangelical Lutheran Church, the United Lutheran Church, and the United Evangelical Lutheran Church. The California Lutheran College will be the only church college not owned by one church body but by five groups working together.

completed will be the physical education units, residential hall, library, science hall and the student center. The College will open in September, 1961, with enrollment of 400 students and 25 faculty members. Starting as a Junior College the plan is to add the third and fourth years consecutively. The master plan is a design for a complete college community in the inspirational setting of the Conejo Valley and located only 20 miles from Los Angeles.
