The programs in schools throughout the Los Angeles System will consist of such activities as open houses, page-ants, and classroom visitations where parents and other citi-zens may learn more about the education program and services provided by the schools.

in celebration of the week, In celebration of the week, nearly all Los Angeles City Schools will feature exhibits of students' work and many thousands of teachers will meet with many thousands of parents to discuss mutual interests — children. However, some schools have found it necessary to schedule programs at times other than the week of April 24-30, Jarvis said.

THREE MAIN objectives of this year's Public Schools Week observance are a better under-standing of how schools teach fundamentals and citizenship, increased confidence by the public in the teaching profes-ters and the recognition of the

increased confidence by the public in the teaching profession, and the recognition of the need for more teachers.

The Public Schools Week was launched in 1920 in San Francisco by Attorney Charles Albert Adams. Adams was a Past Grand Master of the Masonic Lodge of California and for many years served as a member of the California State Board of Education.

During that period there was a great shortage of teachers and classrooms and many schools were closed. Adams' statewide movement was designed to call attention to the needs of schools. Since then Public Schools Week has been annually observed as a period of re-dedication, to the principle of the public school.
