# **Garden Checklist**

### By California Association of Nurserymen

- 1—Look hard for any new signs of aphis and other pests in rose beds. Spray for them only during windless intervals of this often windy month, however.
- 2-A good mulch of steer manure is one sure way of giving hydrangeas the rich, cool, moist soil they so thrive on.
- 3-Seedling tuberous begonias are available in nursery flats now. Plant them in light, not deep, shade for best results.
- 4—Try training tomatoes on a sunny fence or garage wall. You'll be surprised at the crop you get from a few plants.
- 5—Pinch out the growing tips of fuchsias to encourage bushy growth. The fuchsias can be trained by pinching to almost any growth pattern you desire.
