

Coffee Pledgets Aid to Keep U.S. Defense Contracts Alive in Area

Tom Coffee, officially endorsed Republican candidate for the Seventeenth Congressional District of California, is concerned about the loss of defense work for California industry and wage earners.

"With the know-how, research facilities, supply of skilled labor, and natural assets of Southern California, it is not at all understandable why this area should not be receiving its share of government spending," Coffee stated.

In a meeting of Republican workers in Manhattan Beach last night, Coffee pledged that if he is elected, he will devote his energies in the committees of Congress concerned with defense spending to ensure the fact that the many jobs tied in with the defense, electronic, and aircraft industry are secure.

nia aircraft industry is not receiving its fair share of contracts, and that it is not being adequately represented in the United States Congress.

"Layoffs, contract cancellations, and missile mixups are wastes of the taxpayers' money," Coffee declared. "It is not a wise government policy to train men in highly technical skills, spend several years on a project, and then see it moved to another agency or plant due to regional situations of unemployment or for political preference."

THE AIRCRAFT industry is of special concern to Congressman-nominee Coffee, whose district includes Inglewood, Eawthorne, and Lennox, which have been referred to as the Electronics Capital of the World, or the Most Air-Minded Mile in America.

Congressman-nominee Coffee concluded his remarks to the Republican workers with the statement that he will dedicate himself in Congress to protecting the jobs and payrolls of the area, and that this would be his primary concern during his two year term.

Creation of Pedestrian Malls Permitted Under New Legislation

Legislation enacted at the recent special session of the 1960 Legislature will permit cities to create pedestrian malls in downtown districts where traffic congestion has all but throttled easy access to those areas.

Stimulus for the legislation came from successful experiments by cities in other states where pedestrian malls have been established with the general approval of the communities concerned.
