Feds Planning **Booklet About School Growth**

Dr. Charles Fitzwater, chief of the local school administration section of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, last week visited the Torrance Unified School District, with an eye to getting information on operation of a fast growing district.

The government official said Torrance was chosen as a good example of the West Coast for a study his department in making. They are planning to put out a boklet explaining best administrative practices in fast-growing districts, he said.

Dr. Fitzwater previously studied districts in New Mexico, Utah, Colorado, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Minnesota.
