Busy Weekend Scheduled At St. Andrew's Church

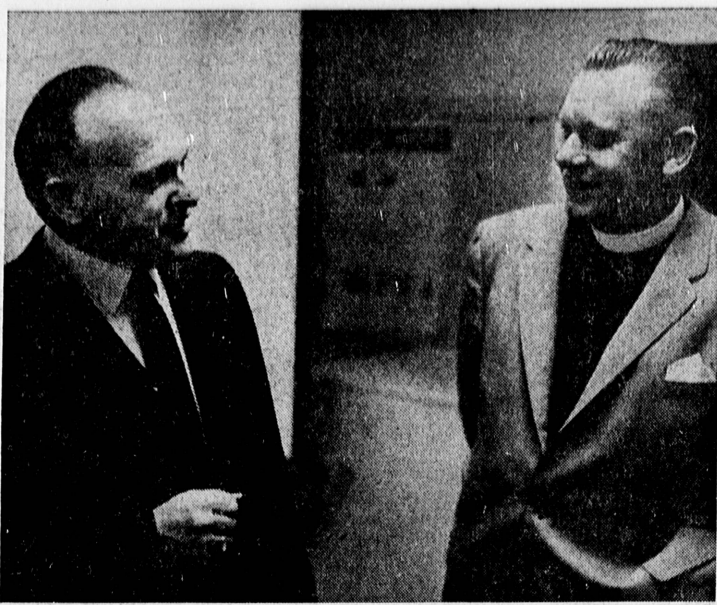
'Sea Festival' Scheduled for Next Saturday
