25 YMCA Boys To Tour Grand Tetons in June

Final arrangements have been completed for the Torrance YMCA's teenage tour to the Grand Teton National Park. The unique trip is designed for boys 13 and older, and will extend from June 22 to July 3.

Twenty-five youngsters will travel first to Salt Lake City for a dip in the Great Salt Lake and a visit to the Mormon Square. Next, they travel past Bear Lake to a campsite on the Snake River. Finally they arrive in the Jackson Hole country for a base camp near Jackson Lake amid the Rocky Mountains.

During their stay, the boys will have a chance to learn the skill of mountain climbing from a Ranger school in the Park. Others will spend their time hiking, fishing, swimming, boating, and exploring the wild country.

On the return trip, the

YMCA group will view Old Faithful Geyser in Yellowstone, Idaho Falls, Craters of the Moon, Great Ruth Copper Mine, and a portion of the High Sierra.

While the Teton trip is the longest YMCA Camp of the summer, it is only one of twelve camping sessions designed for boys and girls from nine years old and up.
