

### Report on Aid to Chilean Earthquake Victims Given

Excellent response to Chilean earthquake victims' urgent needs that countries of the free world are anxious to lend a helping hand in time of distress.

It was the report made to members of the Torrance Branch American Red Cross at the annual meeting by Albert V. Wold, director of public information for the Los Angeles center.

Over \$40,000 has been collected through the special campaign to collect funds for Chilean Relief by Red Cross," said Wold.

HE POINTED out that the drive to collect clothing, food and medicine has been so suc-

cessful that all immediate needs have been met.


"Church organizations of all faiths in Southern California have done an excellent job in collecting and sorting clothing, with fine cooperation of the fire departments," Wold declared.

"THE GREATEST need at the present time is for funds to purchase building supplies—close to 800,000 Chileans are still without a roof over their heads," stated the Red Cross spokesman.
