Proposals will cover the cost of furnishing all labor, material and equipment for the improvement of the above mentioned district by the complete construction and installation therein of a sanitary sewer system together with all other items of work incidental or appurtenant thereto. The estimated quantities are as follows: 15" Extra Strength Vitrified Clay Pipe, 2,948.46 Lin. Ft. Standard and Joints, 11 Each Standard 4' Vitrified Concrete Pipe and Brick (or Concrete) Chimes, 176.89 Vert. Ft. 3" Base Trench Resurfacing, 224 Lin. Ft. 4" Base Trench Resurfacing, 2,768.48 Lin. Ft. The Estimated Total of the Contract Total is \$68,893.05. Bids must be sealed and marked "BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE VICTOR PRECINCT TRUNK SEWER SECTION 15". Bids must be made on the special proposal form furnished by the City Engineer and must be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond, in an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid. Said certified check or bidder's bond will be forfeited should the successful bidder fail to enter into a Contract to do the work herein specified and to furnish the necessary bonds as herein specified within the date of the award of the Contract. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish surety bonds satisfactory to the City Engineer in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid as a guarantee of the faithful performance of the Contract, and for the amount of all labor and materials used in the performance of the work. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1770 of the Labor Code of the State of California, the City Council has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages for the locality in which the work is to be done for each craft or type of workman specified in the execution of this contract. For men, except as otherwise separately classified, shall be paid at less than \$2.00 per day more than the journeyman rate for the craft involved. For women, except as otherwise separately classified, shall be paid at less than one-half the prevailing rate for time worked in excess of eight (8) hours per day or for the sixth consecutive day worked, or holidays, except when the holiday falls on the seventh consecutive day worked which shall be two (2) times the prevailing rate, and two (2) times the prevailing rate for the seventh consecutive day worked, for time worked on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays where such time does not constitute overtime. The foregoing prevailing wage schedule is based upon working day of eight (8) hours and in the event that laborers, workmen, or mechanics are employed less than eight (8) hours per day, the rate for duty shall be deemed to be that fraction of the foregoing rates that the number of hours of employment bears to eight. The rate of compensation for any classification not listed in the schedule, but which may be required to execute the proposed Contract, shall be commensurate and in accord with the rates specified for similar and comparable classification or for those performing similar or comparable duties. It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the contract is awarded, and upon all subcontractors under him, to pay not less than the generally prevailing rates of per diem wages to all workmen employed in the execution of the Contract. The time within which the aforementioned work must be completed by the Contractor undertaking the same has been fixed at thirty (30) working days from and after the date of the execution of the contract agreement.
