Aeronca Realigns Duties Of Two Vice Presidents

The realignment of duties for two vice presidents of Aeronca Manufacturing Corporation was announced today.

Additional duties and responsibilities were assigned to Raymond F. Hermes and John P. Lawler.

Hermes, who has had experience with engineering, contracts, sales, quality control and production, has been named vice president and assistant general manager of Aeronca's Middletown plant which is the company's largest division.

LAWLER continues as vice president and fill direct and manage all sales efforts for the Defense Products Group in-

cluding Middletown, Aeronca and Aerospace Divisions.

Lawler joined the sales department of Aeronca in July, 1955, after being employed in the sales department of Cam-

car Screw and Mfg. Corp. of Chicago, Ill.
